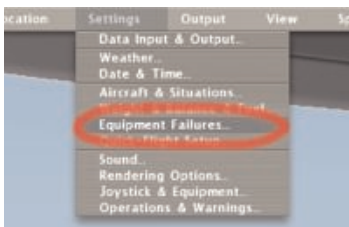


## REPAIRING A BROKEN WHEEL

- Fix a wheel without stopping the train

While driving your X-Train, you may on occasion find yourself in need of a new wheel. Luckily all X-Trains carry a limitless supply of replacement wheels.



In the Settings Menu, select Equipment Failures, and click on the Reset all systems to operational. You're now ready to hit the rails again.



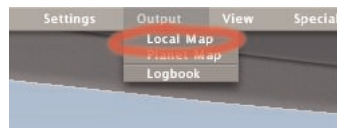

## CALLING A RESCUE TRAIN

- Accidents happen, use the maps window to get yourself back on the tracks again

While driving in the X-World, you may on occasion find yourself in need of a rescue train. X-Train vehicles are built to last, but when they flip on their side (or upside down) they can be a challenge to return to their tracks.

Should the worst happen to your X-Train, here's how to get yourself back on your feet. First, wait until your vehicle has come to a stop. Then, from any one of the local map screens (accessible from the Output menu), add 400 feet in altitude to your current position. To do this, find the altitude display in the upper right of the screen and hit the hundreds digit four times. Hit return to close the window.

Your X-Train will now begin its decent to earth, but should end up wheels down just about as it makes contact. Just prior to contact, return to the Local Map, and this time change the Speed to zero. Hit return again.

If all goes well, your train will gently drop back on its wheels, ready for another round.

## ELECTRIC POWER

- X-Train Electric Railcars run on power provided by an electrified 3rd rail or overhead trolley wire

Well . . . not really, but I've disguised the engine sights and sounds to appear that way. I've also adjusted the engines so you won't have to worry about fuel levels. Just think electric train.

## HARD RAILS/3RD RAIL/TROLLEY POLES OPTION

- Use optional replacement files to add realism to your X-Train experience

Guide your X-Train over "hard" rails and bridges via Electric Third Rails and Fences or Trolley Poles added to your X-Plane railroad tracks. See included ReadMe file for more information.

## REVERSE TRAIN DIRECTION

- X-Train can be controlled by cabs located at either end of the railcar

If you want to reverse train direction, simply follow these steps:

- Shut down train power completely, set brakes
- Walk through the train to the opposite cab – on your way, go to any one of the local maps (accessible from the Output menu) and add 180° to your heading
- Start up power in the new cab and away you go

## ADJUST THE SUNSHADE

- Some X-Train cabs have working sunshades

If you're heading into the sunset and want to pull DOWN the sunshade, follow these steps:

- **COPY** the file `xtrain_panel.png` from the `Alternate_Panels/Down` folder to the X-Train directory (replace the one that's already there)

To pull UP the sunshade, follow these steps:

- **COPY** the file `xtrain_panel.png` from the `Alternate_Panels/Up` folder to the X-Train directory (replace the one that's already there)
